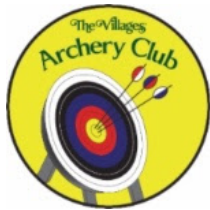


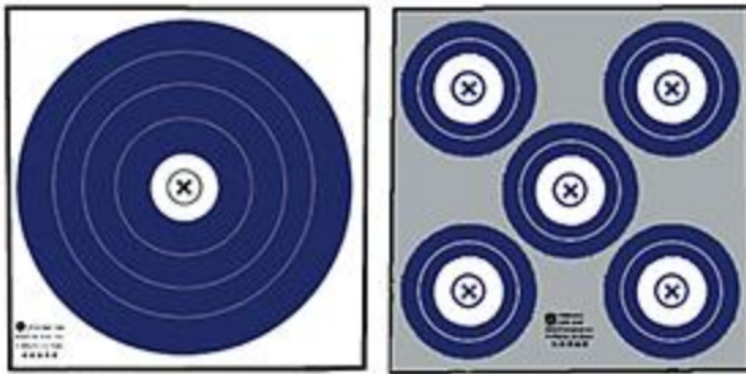

## The Villages Archery Club

The Villages Archery Club runs an 8-week archery league during each season of the year, leaving a 5-week break between leagues. The recently concluded Winter and Spring Leagues both used the “600” format, so to mix things up a bit, the Summer League will use the “300” (“Indoor”) format. The Summer 300 League will run on Monday mornings from July 8 to August 26.

The 300 format consists of 12 ends of 5 arrows at 20 yards using the NFAA blue and white indoor target face. There are 2 versions of that target face, usually printed on opposite sides of the same face:



- The first is the “1-spot”, consisting of 5 rings with values of 5, 4, 3, 2, and 1 point. Arrows outside the 1-ring count as a miss (0 points).
- The second is the “5-spot”, consisting of 5 targets with a 5-ring and a 4-ring. Arrows outside the 4-ring count as a miss. The 5-spot is generally preferred by compound bow shooters more concerned about jamming 5 arrows in a small space than with the possibility of shooting outside the 4-ring.
- You are free to choose whichever face you want regardless of shooting style.

A few notes about the league:

- Handicaps are used to level the playing field. If you competed in the 2023 Summer 300 League, you should already have an established handicap, assuming that you are still shooting at the same level. If your level is not the same (new equipment, advanced skills, etc.) or if you are new, you will need to establish a handicap by shooting a minimum of 4 rounds prior to July 1. Photos of scorecards should be submitted by email to [jeffwiseman@comcast.net](mailto:jeffwiseman@comcast.net).
- Teams of 4 or 5 archers will be constructed on July 1 based on the established handicaps.
- Competition takes place on Monday mornings at 9 AM at either range, Paradise or Dudley. Mondays are preferred but the rules are flexible to allow shooting later in the week or even earlier than Monday if needed due to schedule conflicts.
- League dues are \$10 per archer, all of which is returned as cash prizes at the end of the season.
